Subject: Good-Faith Report of Potential Misrepresentation by Student

Dear Compliance/Community Standards Team,

We are submitting a good-faith concern regarding potential material misrepresentation by an individual identified as:

Name: Alonzo Estrada
Intent: We are raising this concern honestly and responsibly, based on what we've seen, and we think it deserves a closer look.

Purpose of this report

We are not asserting conclusions about intent. We are requesting that the University review whether the representations below are accurate, particularly if they were used in any official university context (e.g., especially if any of these details were used in admissions considerations, scholarship considerations, or campus opportunities).

Summary of concerns

A. Nonprofit impact claims

- **Fact:** Alonzo states he “Founded a non-profit that repurposes recycled waste from local businesses into 10,000+ toys, promoting sustainability and bringing joy to over 20,000 children and families.” He also claims, “Project NextGenEd Co-founded an organization that partnered with 10 underfunded high schools to provide students with hundreds of free resources, guiding them through every stage of the college application process.”
- **Issue:** Public information reviewed indicates significantly lower documented output and/or different organizational structure. Greater Austin, where he grew up, has 72k students, thus he is claiming he gave toys to nearly 28% of ALL students throughout greater Austin. Implausible. If he actually did this work, it was at best a small initiative and he has scaled up his wording, exaggerating metrics significantly, and grossly misrepresented his impact.

B. Leadership / role characterization

Fact: Alonzo's profile claims he was a Secretary-Intern at Materoom. This claim is very curious. The CEO, Steven Wang (steven.wang@matteroom.com) of the firm was contacted about Alonzo's claim. The CEO declared that Alonzo was NEVER involved in any official or sanctioned way with his company. Interestingly enough Alonzo's father was fired from this company after working at it for only four months. Also, Alonzo's profile lists "Business Strategist" at a private company during high school years, but there is no independent confirmation of this title or scope was found in public sources. Specifically, as a 16-17 year old he claims he was a "Business Strategist" for Adaptiv Retail Intelligence. That is extremely unlikely for a real company to hire a completely inexperienced high school student as a Business Strategist.

Issue: It appears Alonzo has completely fabricated work experience. He has never worked for Materoom in any way. His "work" at Materoom and Adaptiv is almost certainly an inflated internship title, or volunteer / shadow role. (More likely, Alonzo's father simply created a fictitious job at Materoom before he got fired.) Thus, on this resume Alonzo has fabricated experience and overstated possible experience.

C. Certifications / credentials

Fact: Alonzo claims a substantial 17 different certifications! None of them shows an issuing body, a date of certification / credential identifier. Clearly for an 18-year-old he is either a genius savant, or a liar. The long list of certifications claimed misleads the reader. How many 18-year-olds have a certification in all of the following areas: Patent Law, American Law, JavaScript, Java, Python, SQL, Data Science, CRM, Sales, Marketing, and Stakeholder Management? The answer is: NONE.

Issue: Listing 17 certifications on one's resume is a blatant lie and over-reach. Given his age, he more likely has zero. He has misrepresented his actual experience.

D. Aggregation of organizational metrics

Fact: Some impact figures appear to reflect organization-level claims rather than clearly attributable individual contributions. Between the ages of 15-18 Alonzo claims three years of "professional" experience, but this is misleading. Serving as a lifeguard, part-time and "internship" is not "professional". It overstates his experience and should be labeled: student / part-time / internship experience.

Issue: Alonzo has twisted potential experience and claimed it as professional.

D. Linguistic Skills Claimed, with no proof

Fact: Alonzo claims native/fluency in Japanese and English. This is possible but needs to be verified with actual proficiency tests or a simple conversation from a native fluent Japanese person. Given the lies and exaggerations of his other statements, it's doubtful he can even write a paragraph in Japanese, let alone be "native".

Issue: Alonzo needs to verify through national or international standardized tests that he is actually fluent in Japanese.

Reason for concern

If any of the above information was used in **official university processes**, it may constitute:

- Material misrepresentation
- Inaccurate reporting of achievements or credentials

Furthermore, if any of this material is used on Alonzo's resume it will misrepresent his actual skills and abilities, misrepresent the ethics and standards of the University and pollute the candidate pool.

Alonzo's claims on his resume were likely used throughout his admissions process, misrepresenting his impact and capabilities. If he was granted access to the school under false pretenses, he should be removed from school. As a current Business student, Alonzo is actively misrepresenting internships, over-inflating work experience and vastly over-stating his certifications and generally misrepresenting his skills and capabilities. This negligent conduct reflects poorly on UT students and alumni. He should be removed from the school.

Requested action

We respectfully request that the University:

- Review the accuracy of these representations
- Determine whether any university policies are implicated
- Take any action deemed appropriate under university guidelines

In summary, any student who engages in material misrepresentation, false claims of nonprofit impact, misleading professional titles, claiming an internship but the CEO has denied it, vastly overstates certification achievements should be barred from the UT system.

If you are serious about keeping fairness and integrity as a hallmark of your student body, then all students must operate under the UT code of ethics. We encourage you to compel Alonzo to fully verify every single fact on his resume. Show websites, validate with vetted/notarized documents, dig several levels deep to truly verify this person's claims, etc.

There are too many fabrications, misrepresentations and falsehoods to not take this student's apparent widespread ethical breach seriously. It is entirely reasonable to assume he leveraged this information in his application to enter UT. Thus, he has deeply misrepresented himself to the University and all students who tried so hard (and truthfully!) to gain admission the school.

Bottom line: **This student is not trustworthy and he has demonstrated decorum and judgement not fitting to be a UT student.** Each item on his resume requires FULL VERIFICATION to allow this person to continue his studies at the university.
